Dear Parents and Carers,

November 2020

Your child may be able to get Free School Meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Universal credit **(not working)**
- Universal Credit **(working and earnings are less than £616.67 for 1 payment period, or less than £1,233.34 for 2 payment periods or less than £1,850.00 for 3 payment periods)**
- Child Tax Credit, **(provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)**
- Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit Run-on, paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Children who receive any of the above benefits in their own right (ie they get payments directly, instead of through a parent or guardian) can also get free school meals

If you think that your child is entitled to Free School Meals then we urge you to apply via the link as soon as possible: https://contactus.salford.gov.uk/?formtype=FSM_IBASSE

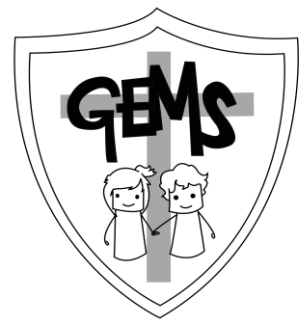
