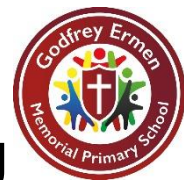

Key Vocabulary	Definition
continuous	Something that happens without stopping
horizontal	Flat or level with the ground and not at an angle to it
vertical	Pointing straight up at a 90 degree angle from a horizontal base
observe	To look at something carefully
diagonal	A line that is straight and sloping
wavy	Curvy in shape
texture	A surface quality that is not flat
line	A mark on a surface can be different lengths, widths and create shapes
two dimensional	a flat image or shape; like a drawing
