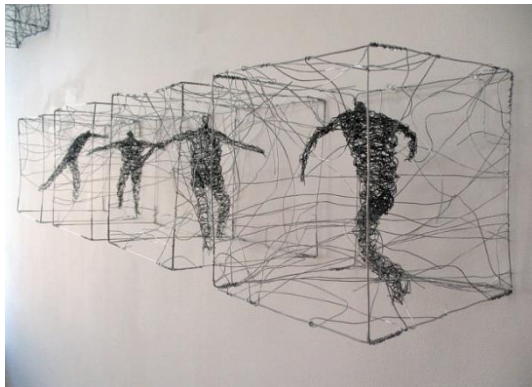

My Key Learning



Installation art is art that is placed in a space to convey a message (concept).

Antony Gormley is a British sculptor. He often puts figures in landscape or cityscape.



What do I already know?

Carving



Hard materials such as wood or stone can be carved to change their shape. Cut or scrape away pieces of the material to make a sculpture.

Found objects



Material: not usually thought of as art materials can be used to make sculptures, e.g. scrap metal, old toys, pieces of furniture.

Shadows can create sculpture.

Sculptors to use sketchbooks and annotations to plan their sculptures.

Nnenna Okore is a Nigerian artist who uses ecologically friendly materials to create her art to convey her message.
