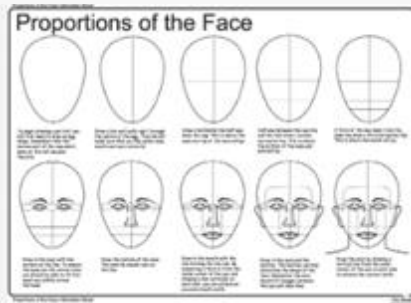

Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>chiaroscuro</b>	Italian work meaning 'light-dark' or 'light & shade'.
<b>composition</b>	putting different elements together in a pleasing way
<b>mark making</b>	the creation of different lines, patterns or shapes
<b>mural</b>	a painting applied to a wall or ceiling
<b>still life</b>	painting or drawing of an arrangement of objects
<b>technique</b>	The way in which an artist uses certain skills in their artwork
<b>tonal</b>	how light or dark a colour or shade is
<b>tone</b>	how light or dark something is
