Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Past</b>	A time that has gone
<b>Present</b>	What is happening now
<b>Toy</b>	An object for a child to play with
<b>Timeline</b>	A way we show important events in the order that they happened.
<b>Living memory</b>	Events, people or objects that can be remembered by people who are still alive
<b>Artefact</b>	An object of historical interest made by a human being
<b>Sources</b>	A place, person or object that provides information
<b>Compare</b>	To say what is the same and what is different
