**Godfrey Ermen**

This is Godfrey Ermen. He was a successful mill owner who lived in Patricroft in the 1800s.

He was the head of the cotton firm Ermen and Engels.

When he died he left money in his will to be used for the benefit of any charitable or educational worthwhile endeavour- our school was built with this money.



**L.S. Lowry**

Godfrey Ermen

This is L.S. Lowry he was a Salford born artist. He painted pictures of the industrial North West in the 1930s to the late 1950s.

One of his most famous paintings is called 'Coming from the Mill'.
