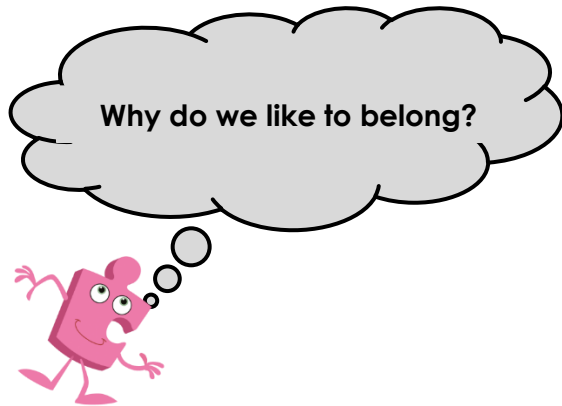

Key Vocabulary	Definition
assumptions	A thing that is accepted as true, without proof.
differences	A point or way in which people or things are not the same.
diversity	People can be different in many ways such as race, gender, culture and appearance.
fairness	Giving everyone the same chance to get involved.
shield	Something or someone that gives protection.
similarities	Some things, but not all are the same.
special	Better, greater or different from usual.
stereotypes	A mistaken belief or idea about someone based upon how they look.
unique	Something or someone who is important and special.
value	Something that is important and worthwhile.
