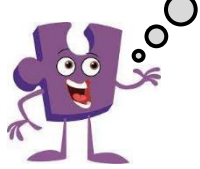

UNIT 2: Celebrating Difference



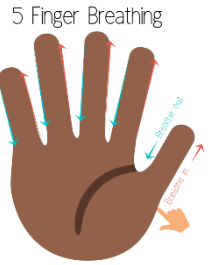
Key Vocabulary	Definition
bully	Someone who looks to hurt or harm others who they consider to be vulnerable/easy to target.
bystander	Person who is present at an event but does not take part.
compliment	A polite expression of praise or admiration.
conflict	A disagreement or argument.
connected	Associated or related to something.
consequences	A result or an effect that can sometimes be unpleasant.
gay	People who love other people of the same gender e.g. a man loving a man or a woman loving a woman.
resolve	To find a decision or an end to something.
solutions	The act or process of answering a problem or question.
witness	A person who sees an event take place.
