Key Vocabulary	Definition
accept	To agree to something.
appearance	This is what someone looks like.
bystander	Person who is present at an event but does not take part.
cyberbullying	A way of bullying people electronically, usually through nasty or threatening messages.
impression	An idea, feeling or opinion about something or someone.
influence	To affect or change something, often indirectly.
judgement	A decision or opinion given after some consideration.
opinion	A view or judgement formed about something, not necessarily based on fact or knowledge.
problem-solve	To find a decision or an end to something.
troll	Someone who leaves an offensive message on the internet, in order to upset someone.
