asylum seeker	person who left their country due to dangers, to seek a safer country elsewhere
citizen	a member of a place or country and is accepted as belonging
conflict	a struggle, battle or disagreement
collaboration	working with someone to produce something
democracy	rule by the people. In a democracy people elect the government by voting and have a say in how it is run.
migrant	someone who chooses to move mainly to improve their life or seek work
opinion	a personal judgement, thought or belief
prejudice	a pre-conceived opinion that is not based on reason or experience
refugee	someone who has been given the right to stay in a country because they're unsafe in their home country
UNCRC	The United Nations Convention on Rights of the Child
