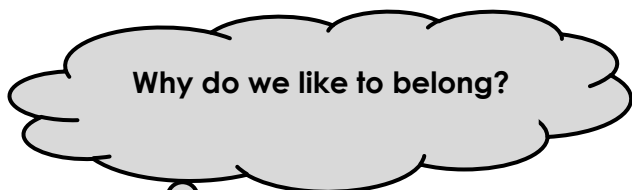

Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>banter</b>	The exchange of teasing remarks, sometimes playful.
<b>conflict</b>	A serious disagreement or argument.
<b>culture</b>	Ideas, customs and behaviour of a particular people or society.
<b>cyberbullying</b>	A way of bullying people electronically, usually through nasty or threatening messages.
<b>direct</b>	This means that someone says what they mean.
<b>discrimination</b>	The unjust or prejudiced treatment of people based on colour or race.
<b>homophobic</b>	Having or showing a dislike or prejudice against homosexual people.
<b>indirect</b>	Not directly caused by or resulting from something.
<b>racism</b>	Prejudice or discrimination directed against someone of a different race based on the belief that one's own race is superior.
<b>rumour</b>	A currently circulating story or report of uncertain or doubtful truth.
