

Key Vocabulary	Definition
banter	The exchange of teasing remarks, sometimes playful.
conflict	A serious disagreement or argument.
culture	Ideas, customs and behaviour of a particular people or society.
cyberbullying	A way of bullying people electronically, usually through nasty or threatening messages.
direct	This means that someone says what they mean.
discrimination	The unjust or prejudiced treatment of people based on colour or race.
homophobic	Having or showing a dislike or prejudice against homosexual people.
indirect	Not directly caused by or resulting from something.
racism	Prejudice or discrimination directed against someone of a different race based on the belief that one's own race is superior.
rumour	A currently circulating story or report of uncertain or doubtful truth.


