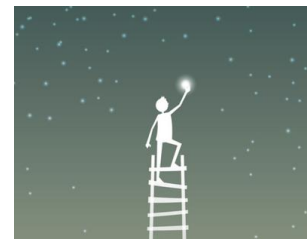

contribution	A part played by a person to bring a result to something.
job	A paid position of regular employment or a task to complete.

profession	A paid occupation, especially one that involves longer training.
rallying	The action of coming together for a cause.
salary	A fixed regular payment for undertaking a job.
sponsorship	Financial support received from a person or company.
support	To give approval, comfort or encouragement to someone.
