What do I already know?

Christians say that there are four main types of prayer:

- praising
- saying sorry
- saying thank you
- asking for something

Some Jewish people wear the Star of David, the kippah (cap for men) and may have a prayer shawl.

Other symbols include the Menorah and the Mezuzah.



What is precious to Jewish people?

The **Star of David** is precious to Jewish people.



Some things found in a Jewish family home:

mezuzah



prayer books



kippah (cap)

tallit (prayer shawl)

candlesticks



challah bread

chanukiah



What is a Mezuzah?

The **Shema** prayer is rolled up inside telling Jewish people about God:

Hear O Israel, the Lord is our God, the Lord is one.



A Mezuzah is put on door frames of houses to remind them to say the Shema prayer and think about God.

How and why do Jewish people celebrate Shabbat?

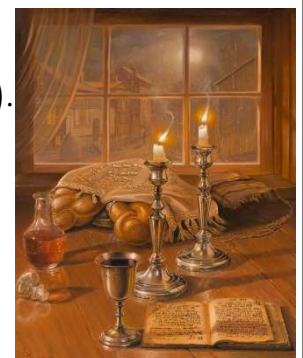
Shabbat begins on Friday night with a special meal.

During the meal, candles are lit, people pray and say blessings, they eat the special bread (challah).

On Saturday, Jewish people go to the synagogue

Jewish people remember the day that God rested after creating the world.

They thank God for the creation of the world.
