In all religions, we are reminded that everyone is special and unique.

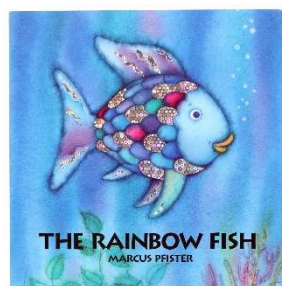
Christians and Jews believe that God values everyone.

Friendship

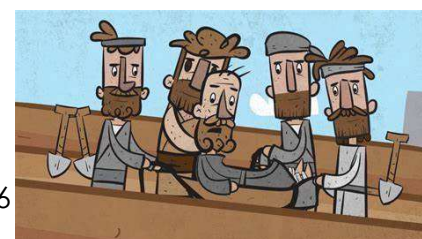
Friends take care of each other.
