Gospels

The Gospels are the first 4 books of the New Testament in the Bible. Gospels are stories of "Good News" that Jesus brought.

Jesus chose 12 disciples to help him. They all came from different backgrounds and were not always popular.

Jesus was a friend to the friendless. One of the disciples, Matthew, was a tax collector. He wrote the longest gospel.

Zacchaeus was also a tax collector who spoke with Jesus.



Forgiveness:

Jesus taught people that God will forgive them. Jesus reminded people to forgive others.

Peace:

Jesus taught people that God promises peace to people who believe in him.

Jesus brought good news to Christians and so many Christians try to show this to others by:

- Giving to people in need
- Saying sorry
- Asking for forgiveness

Confession:

Some Christians tell the vicar about the things they have done that they want forgiveness for.

Church:

Features in a church help Christians to remember the teachings of Jesus.
