What do I already know?

Allah is the word for God in Arabic.

Muslims believe that there is only God. They use the word **Tawhid**.

The Prophet Muhammad was God's messenger.

Shahada is one of the five pillars and is the core belief:

ibadah	the Arabic word for worship
inspire	to encourage and fill someone with ideas
Kaaba	important building to Muslims in the city of Mecca
mosque	place of worship for Muslims
muezzin	person who calls Muslims to pray at the mosque
pilgrimage	a journey to a holy place
ritual	a regular ceremony or sequence of actions
wisdom	showing how to make sensible decisions using what you know

Allah:

Muslims never draw pictures of Allah because they believe Allah is too big for pictures.

Stories of Muhammad

Muslims do not draw pictures of Muhammad.

Muhammad was believed to be very wise.

The story of the Black Stone shows Muhammad's wisdom.



The Kaaba is an important building in Mecca.



The story of Bilal teaches Muslims about being fair and just.

Bilal was the first person to call Muslims to prayer from the mosque.

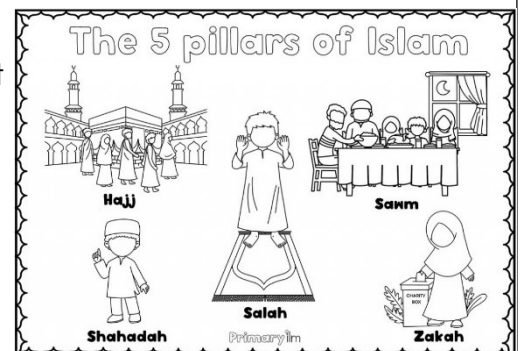
Prayers:

There are five rules that are followed in Islam – **they are called the Five Pillars.**

Salah focuses on prayer.

Muslims pray on a Mat with their heads bowed down.

They pray three to five times a day. This helps them to remember God throughout the day.
