### What do I already know?

Christians, Jews and Muslims believe there is a Creator of the world – God.

Creation is the beginning of the Big Story in the Bible.



Christians traditionally thank God for the world during Harvest by giving and sharing with those in need.

### God's Big Story:

Creation and God are the start of the Big Story.

The story of Creation is in the first book of the Bible – Genesis.

The world began with everything being **good** – “God saw that it was good.” Genesis 1

Christians thank God for the world He created.

Some people who are not Christians or who do not have a faith do not believe God created the World.

People still want to care for the world whether they have faith or not.
