What do I already know?

Christians, Jews and Muslims believe there is a Creator of the world – God.

Creation is the beginning of the Big Story in the Bible. The first book of the Bible is called Genesis.



The world began with everything being **good** – “God saw that it was good.” Genesis 1

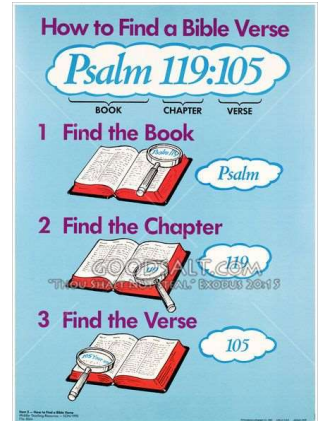
God’s Big Story:

The Bible is made up of two sections – the Old Testament and the New Testament.

The Old Testament is made of stories before Jesus. The New Testament tells stories of Jesus’s life (Gospels) and after Jesus died.

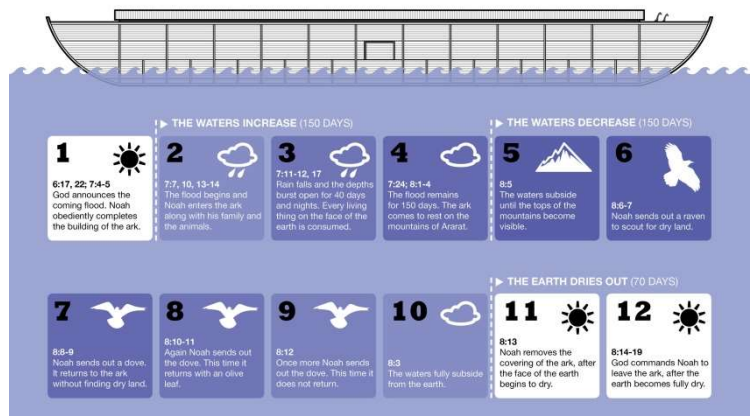
How to find a Bible verse:

The Old Testament stories tell stories of people’s friendships and faith in God.



NOAH’S ARK GENESIS 6-9

LENGTH: 300 cubits = 450ft / 140m BREADTH: 50 cubits = 75ft / 23m DEPTH: 30 cubits = 45ft / 14m



Noah made a promise to God to follow his rules. He made a **pact**. Noah was trying to live by God’s rules.

People make **covenants** in their lives. A covenant is a promise made in weddings, for example, for people with and without a faith.

The rainbow is a symbol of God’s promise for both Christians and Jews. It is a symbol of **hope** and **trust** in God.



Christians believe that following God is to trust and obey God. They believe that God will keep promises and show forgiveness.
