## UNIT L2.5 Why do Christians call the day Jesus died “Good Friday”? **My Key Learning**



### What do I already know?

#### Salvation:

Christians believe that Jesus gave them a life in heaven.



Christians see the Easter story as the hope that there is a place in Heaven for them. A place of joy.

The Easter story took place 33 years after Jesus was born.

It is an important celebration for Christians.

### 3 key events in Holy Week:

The Easter story is the story of salvation – God sent Jesus to save and rescue people from sin.

#### Palm Sunday (Matthew 21: 7-11) - hope



Jesus and his disciples arrived in Jerusalem. People celebrated waving palm leaves and shouting “Alleluia!”

#### Good Friday (Luke 23: 13-25; 32-48) - sadness

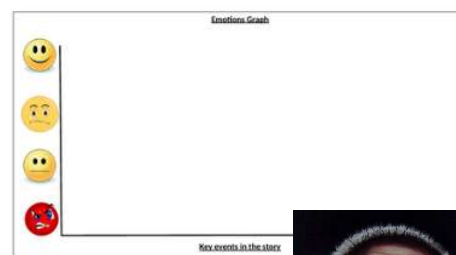
Jesus was crucified. As he died the sky turned black. His body was placed in a tomb.



#### Easter Sunday (Luke 24: 1-12) - joy

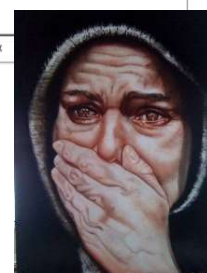


Jesus left the tomb and rose from the dead.



#### Mary's emotions:

despair	fearful	devastated

#### Christian beliefs and traditions:

Christians believe that Jesus shows them how to live a life that pleases God. A life of love for all.

The stations of the cross in church retell the story of Jesus's final journey. They are displayed in churches.

Resurrection means bringing back to life.
