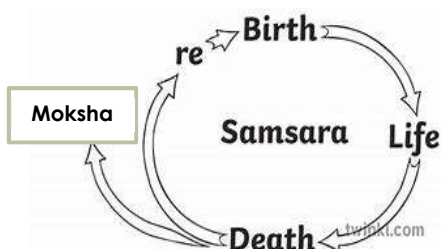
UNIT U2.12 How does faith help people when life gets hard?

My Key Learning



What do I already know?

Samsara is the Hindu belief in the life cycle and how you live your life.



The mainstream Christian belief is that Jesus was a sacrifice for all men. Jesus was punished in place of everyone. They believe Jesus' death was not the end. They use the word **resurrection**.

Most Christians believe in life after death and a life in Heaven –

There are times in life that are difficult and some people use their faith or personal beliefs to help them.

It is a human belief that we should be thankful for the good things in life.

Christians reflect on Psalm 103 to show their thanks and praise to God.

People without faith might look at other ways to show their **gratitude**.

The story of Job:

The story of Job, in both Jewish and Christian scriptures, demonstrates how a person with faith can be helped in difficult times.



Job was challenged with his faith in God when given lots of bad news. Job remained true to his faith despite being tested by the devil.

In times of bereavement and grief, not everyone believes in life after death.

People use ceremony and rituals to help them in their grief. Not all of these ceremonies are linked to faith.

People pray or think about the person that has died. They might sing songs that are religious but they also mark someone's life with memories, songs and poems.



Images of "heaven" or the "afterlife" look different according to a beliefs and teachings.
