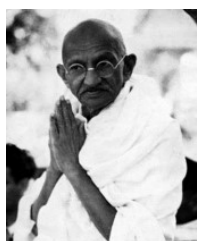

UNIT U2.6 For Christians, what kind of king is Jesus?



What do I already know?

Gandhi was a Hindu religious leader in India. He believed in **sewa**; acts of kindness without expecting anything in return.



A martyr is someone who died for their beliefs, religion or cause. They died to make the world a better place. Martin Luther King is included.



This links with the Christian belief that Jesus died to make the world a better place.

Jesus' Temptation:

Before he died, Jesus spent 40 days and nights in the wilderness, The devil tempted him throughout this time. Jesus refused the offer of being king of all nations on Earth by the devil. He does not see kingship like this.



Jesus wanted the world to be more like heaven – led by the commandments of love God and love your neighbour.

The parable of **The Feast** (Luke 14: 12-24) shows this.



The parable of **The Tenants in the Vineyard** (Matthew 21: 33-46) was Jesus reminding people that God welcomes people who are kind to all but people do not always want to do this.

Jesus was called the "Son of God" in John's Gospel. The Old Testament called prophets "Servants of the Lord".

The chief priests were Jesus' enemies and were jealous of his popularity. They called for the death of Jesus.

The modern world:

Charities seek to make the world a better place and like the "Kingdom of God".



There are lots of groups seeking to make the world a better place for everyone.



There are groups beyond the Christian faith who seek to make the world better.
