<u>Lateness</u>

If you arrive with your child after 8.45am, the playground gates will be locked as lessons begin at 8:45am. After this time, bring your child to the School Office to sign them in. Whilst we know that sometimes things happen to cause occasional lateness, it is so important to be on time for



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school, as this sets good expectations and good habits for life. We are very grateful for your support in getting your child to school on time.

Uniform

Please ensure your child comes into school in the correct uniform everyday. Details of the policy can be found <u>Microsoft Word - School Uniform Policy - GEMS 2023 (gems-salford.co.uk)</u> PE kits need to be brought in separately to change into their kit in school.

As the weather is getting colder, please can we remind you that the children need to have warm coats and jumpers. Children are encouraged to bring black jogging bottoms and a black jumper (no logos) for their PE sessions. Please make sure that children have suitable footwear and, if they come to school in wellies, that they have a change of footwear to make sure that they are comfortable.

If you are finding uniform difficult to get hold of, please come and speak to us about any support you or your child might need. Thank you to the parents that continue to share their pre-loved uniform with us. This is so helpful and much appreciated. Don't forget our pre-loved uniform in the main entrance!

It is recommended in the uniform policy that long hair be tied up and <u>long hair must be tied up</u> for PE and swimming. Make up and nail varnish/false nails must to be removed before coming to school.

We expect children to look smart at all times as they represent our school so well so we will continue to promote our uniform expectations.

Jewellery/Earrings

Please note that for health and safety reasons, we do not allow jewellery in school and that only stud earrings are allowed and a watch (no smart watches). On PE days, stud earrings should be taken out at home, so your child can take part safely in all lessons.

School dinners

Please make sure that you order your child's school dinners in advance. Don't forget to talk to your child about their dinners you can make a choice together and know what they are having. In the cold weather, you may prefer your child to have a hot dinner. Please speak to the office if you need any help with accessing school dinners.

There are opportunities to try out school dinners with our regular theme days – keep an eye on SeeSaw for more information as the year goes on!

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Healthy Schools and Allergies

Please make sure that your child has a water bottle with them. No metal or glass bottles please.

Packed lunches need to be healthy – so we want to remind you to not put sweets or chocolate into the lunches – thank you!

We are a nut-free school so request that children are not sent with anything in their lunches that could contain nuts or nut products.

Please do not send cakes and sweets into school for birthdays – we are mindful of allergies and the risks this entails.

After School Clubs

Our after school clubs will be starting in the week beginning 15th January and will run for the whole of this term. A letter and a google form will be sent out this week for you to sign up to.
