
Key Stage 1 Online Safety Consent Form

Never engage in a 'flame war' - that is a shouting match through text conducted between 2 or more people.

Never send an email in capital letters. That is considered to be shouting on the Internet.

Never put personal information, such as your address or phone number, on the discussion board.

Never say nasty or untrue things about others or use inappropriate language (swear words). These remain on record long after you have posted it!
