We hope that you have all had a lovely Summer and are looking forward to the start of the school year. We are excited to welcome you all back for the start of another great year!

### Start of the Year – Key Information

#### The School Day – starts at 8.45am

Please remember that the School Day starts promptly at **8.45 am** and finishes at **3:15pm**. Therefore, the school gates will open as follows:

**EYs and KS1 Gate on School Road** – the gate will open at 8.30am <u>but will close at 8.45am</u>. Parents and Carers must wait with their child until the Classroom doors open at 8.40am. Gates open at 3:00pm for you to wait for your children at the end of the day.

N and KS2 Gate on Edison Road – the gate will open at 8.35am <u>but will close at 8.45am</u>.

Nursery Parents/Carers must wait with their child until the Classroom doors open at 8.40am. KS2 children are welcome to wait on the KS2 Playground until the Classroom doors open at 8.40am. Gates open at 3:00pm for you to wait on the playground at the end of the day.

If you are collecting from 2 different parts of school, please pick up your youngest child first. Staff will wait for you to collect other children. Please speak to staff if there are any issues.

#### Lateness

If you arrive with your child after 8.45am, the playground gates will be locked as lessons begin at 8:45am. After this time, you will need to bring your child to the School Office to sign them in. Whilst we know that sometimes things happen to cause occasional lateness, it is so important to be on time for school, as this sets good expectations and good habits for life. We are very grateful for your support in getting your child to school on time.

#### <u>Uniform</u>

Please ensure your child comes into school in the correct uniform everyday. Details of the policy can be found on the school website in letters and policies. They will need to bring their PE kit separately and get changed into their kit in school. Please send them with the correct kit at the start of the half term.

## **Healthy Schools and Allergies**

Please make sure that yo<mark>ur child ha</mark>s a water bottle with them. No metal or glass bottles please. Children can fill up their water bottles throughout the day.

Packed lunches need to be healthy – so we request that you do not put sweets or chocolate into the lunches – thank you!

We are a nut-free school so request that children are not sent with anything in their lunches that could contain nuts or nut products.

#### **Birthdays**

We are aware that food allergies are on the rise, which brings such a risk to some children in our school. We do not want some children to be excluded from certain birthday treats because they have a food intolerance. We are also acutely aware of the continuing rising cost of living which is affecting all of us. Therefore, continuing on from last academic year, we want to remind you not to send in birthday treats for the children in class – but we will help your child to celebrate their special day in school! Your child can still come into school in their own clothes and we will all enjoy singing 'Happy Birthday' to them at the end of the day. Thank you in advance for your support and understanding with this issue.
